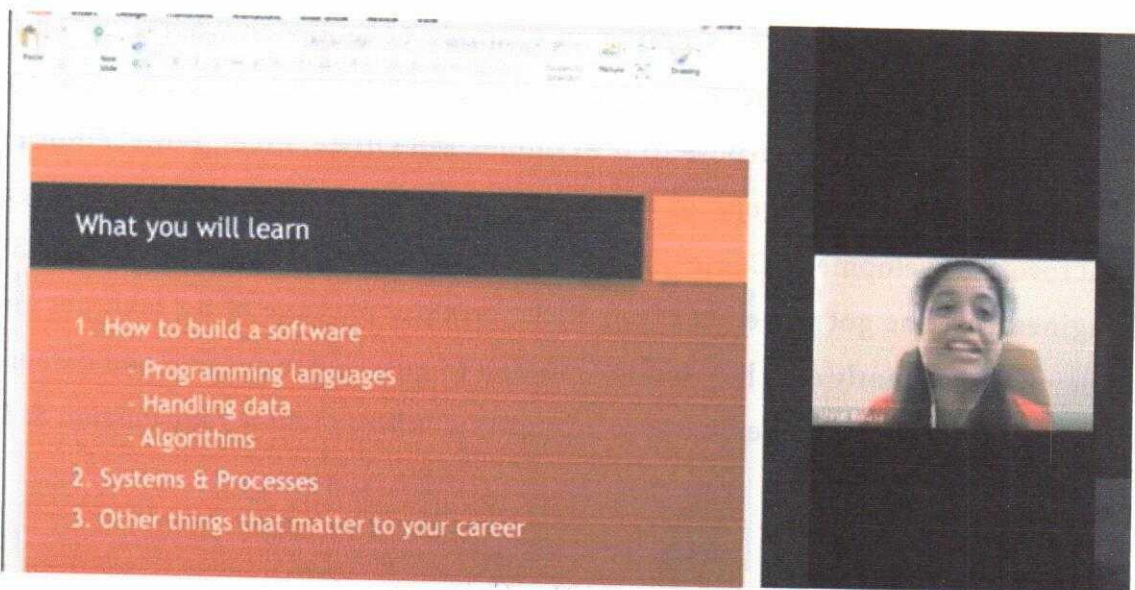
Topic: “Lets decode the code behind Software” & “Sprouting Technology”
