Topic: "Talent is Overrated"

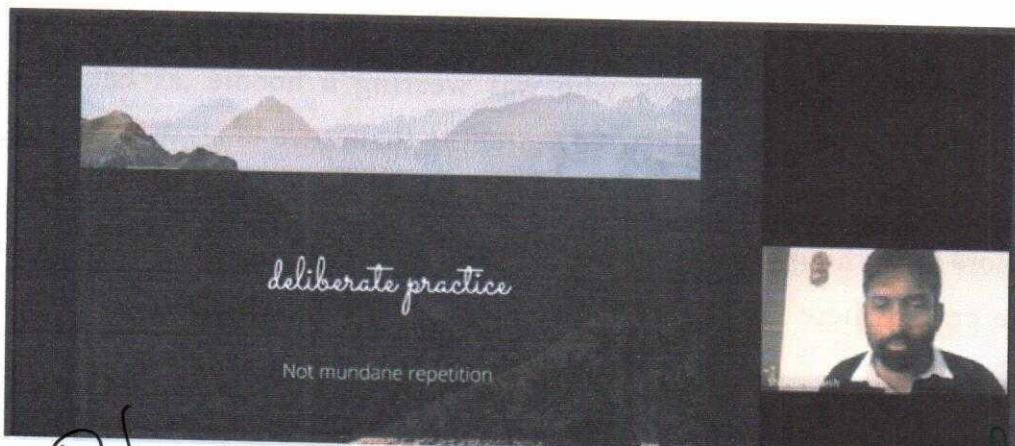
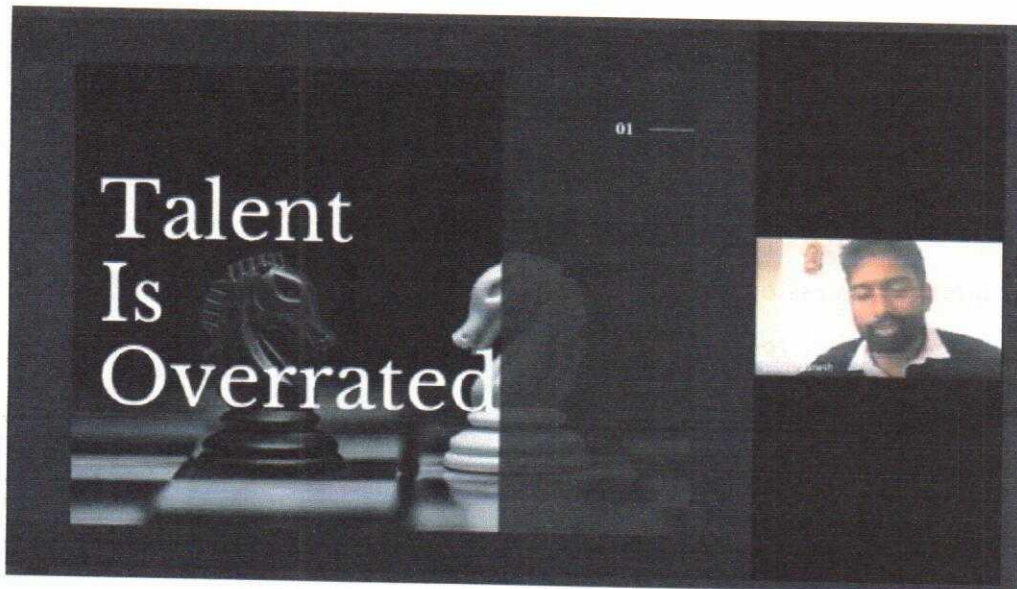
"I think the success of any college can be measured by the contribution the alumni make to our national life"-John F.Kenedy
