

# **SCHOLARSHIP/ FREESHIP POLICY**

K.LE. Society, Belagavi has been established in 1916 by seven dedicated teachers to disseminate education to the doorstep of needy and downtrodden people of North Karnataka. S. Nijalingappa College is a prestigious institution of KLE follows the historical tradition and committed to the vision for supporting top calibre students of underprivileged families. The college was established in 1963 with the objective of in order that no student is denied the opportunity due to financial inadequacy. Scholarships and Freeships are provided by the institution, Government, non-government bodies and philanthropists.

Institution constitutes the scholarship committee which includes the senior faculty/ HoD/ coordinators of the departments. The committee counsel the students during the admission and orientation programme. The committee also follows the guidelines passed by the governing body of the college.

Scholarship is either directly credited to the bank accounts of students by the granting authority or in case where the amount is credited to the institution, the same is immediately credited to the bank accounts of students.

## A. Management Sponsored Scholarship

## I. Role of Management

Management believes in empowering the needy meritorious students by extending the support for higher education, as a part of institutional social responsibility. Such scholarships may cover tuition and related expenses, as applicable, and are awarded as per the conditions listed in this document.

## **II.** Procedure

- The candidates are required to submit the proposal/ application to the principal
- The proposal should enclose the academic details, scanned self-attested copies of required documents viz., SSLC/10<sup>th</sup>/CBSE, PUC/12<sup>th</sup> Std Marks cards, Caste/ Income Certificate/ Aadhar Card, bank account details, character certificate and recent passport size photograph should be submitted to the office before the last date along with admission application forms.
- The Candidates will be required to produce these documents in original for verification by the office whenever requested.

- Any application found incomplete or incorrect will not be considered.
- The governing body review the proposals and approve based on the merit and financial status.
- The selected candidates are eligible to avail the following concessions:
  - 1. A concession in/ complete waiver of tuition fees
  - 2. Books and study materials

## **III.** Eligibility

- The candidate must be a citizen of India
- Have received an unconditional admission offer from the college (applicable to 1<sup>st</sup> year applicants only)
- Have maintained the minimum attendance as specified by the college rules and regulations
- Candidate must not be a beneficiary of any other scholarship award provided by any party.
- The award of scholarships will be made based on one or more of the following prerequisites:
  - Academic Performance in the preceding academic year for the economically backward.
  - Academic merit for differently abled.
  - Excellence in sports.
  - Excellence in social work or community service.
  - Single parent/ Disabled parent

## **IV. Selection**

- A Selection Committee will be constituted by the management, comprising of the Principal, Student welfare officer, Sports Director, and HoD/ Coordinators.
- The committee reviews all the proposals/ applications and recommend the students as per the guidelines.
- Such students will be notified for further action.
- Only one scholarship will be awarded per student, per academic year.

## V. Conditions for Termination of Scholarship Award

• The award may be terminated at any given point in time, if it is found that the candidate has furbished incorrect details/particulars in their application, or is found guilty of malpractice, misconduct, and violation of college policies, rules and regulations.

## Earn While Learn Scheme

The college organize the events like trade fair, Prerana, food fest, to promote the in-house scheme 'Earn while learn' that enable deserving candidates to meet their routine expenses and related expenses, as applicable, while also developing a work ethic.

## B. Government Sponsored Scholarship (SSP/ NSP)

## I. Instruction for Online applications for SSP Scholarship.

- The students should start by going to the official website for the scholarship.
- Click Create Account after the main page has loaded to access a new page.
- Student should pick a plan on the same page.
- Student must choose caste or class from dropdown.
- Student must choose their college's district and taluk.
- If the student should choose Yes if he/she has an Aadhaar card.
- Student should complete the Aadhaar-related fields and press the submit button.
- Student should provide email address and mobile number.
- The student will get an OTP, on providing the mobile number and must input the same in OTP box.
- The information on the students' caste certificate, including religion, category, caste certificate number, etc., must be provided.
- Now input the data from your income certificate.
- If ration card is available enter that data as well.
- Create a password and submit it.
- Register for an account on the SSP Scholarship Portal by completing above steps.

## II. Eligibility For SSP Pre Matric Scholarship 2023-24

- Students must be Karnataka residents.
- The Scheduled Caste (SC), Scheduled Tribe (ST), and Other Backward
- Classes (OBC) are requirements for enrolment.
- Students in grades one through ten are eligible for this grant.
- Students' family income should not be more than Rs 1 lakh annually.
- Students must have passed their final qualifying test with at least a 50% grade point average.
- Candidates of non-working parents who are unable to provide their children's fundamental necessities, such as an education, are eligible for the scholarship.

## III. Objective of SSP Scholarship

The SSP scholarship's primary goal is to provide financial aid to all students who live in Karnataka. These scholarships assist deserving students from many fields who, for financial reasons, are unable to continue their studies. So that they will not be under any financial constraints from their family while they pursue their education. SSP scholarships are available from kindergarten through higher education.

- The SSP scholarship site has been developed to meet the requirements of all students in Karnataka seeking scholarships.
- The amount of the award will be sent straight into the bank account under this scholarship program.
- The state's dropout rates will also go down.
- Financial difficulties no longer force the student to halt their study.
- It should be noted that only residents of Karnataka are eligible for this scholarship program.
- Post-matric and pre-matric scholarship programs are offered via the website.

#### Note:

i) For physically challenged or handicap students, eligibility percentage of marks will be pass marks in all categories.

ii) At the time of continuation (Repeat) of scholarship in all categories, minimum percentage of marks for continuation will be relaxed by 5%

#### D. Faculty/ Alumni Sponsored Scholarship

Faculty and alumni of the college observed that the scholarship from Government/ NGO and philanthropist is not sufficient. To provide the financial assistance to the meritorious students studying in UG/ PG programmes, the faculty and alumni contribute some lump sum amount in the form of scholarship.

#### I. Objective

The primary goal is to provide financial aid to meritorious and socio-economically underprivileged students of the college. The scholarships assist deserving students from many fields who, for financial reasons, are unable to continue their studies. So that they will not be under any financial constraints from their family while they pursue their education. The scholarships are available from UG and PG students.

#### **II.** Eligibility

The students who have scored centum or higher merit of marks, academic progress, attendance, extracurricular activities and who are not able to pay the course expenditure are identified by the committee.

#### **III. Procedure**

The short-listed students and their parents are interviewed to confirm the requirement. The scholarship amount will be paid to the parent through cheque during college annual day celebration.

#### E. Philanthropist Sponsored Scholarship

Some of the Philanthropists and well-wishers of the KLE Society have established endowment scholarship for the meritorious students of the college. Sri. Armagam an industrialist and alumnus of the college has deposited a fixed amount in the name of college. The interest earned every year will be awarded as scholarship to the students who score highest marks in UG programme.
