Institute has established SC/ ST Welfare cell to support and to bring students from such communities in the main stream. IQAC of the college has initiated the implementation of equality and priority to the downtrodden students and staffs as per the direction of the University Grants Commission (UGC) and Governments. The main aim of the Cell is to monitor the guidelines issued by the UGC and Governments, from time-to-time Scheduled Castes (SC) and Scheduled Tribes (ST) has been notified as the two most backward groups of Indian Society. They include all the castes, races, or tribes, which have been socially, economically, and educationally backward.

#### Vision

- To ensure the effective implementation of the reservation policy in admission, recruitment, admissions to hostels etc.
- To promote the special interests of students in the reserved category and guides the students to utilise the benefits of the schemes offered by the Government.

- Facilitating the students to apply for caste/ income certificate, free bus application forms are provided.
- In last four years 735 SC & ST have received scholarships of Amount Rs. 68.76 Lakhs.
