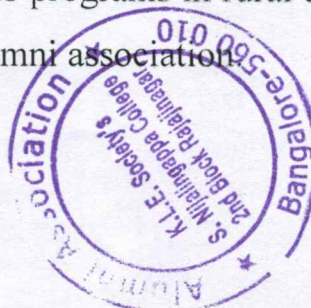

Report on Annual Alumni Association Meet 2019-2020

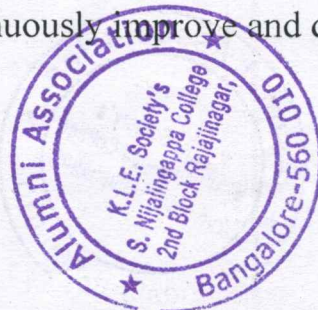

1. Dr. Rajanna, expressed his happiness for being invited to the college. He was so overwhelmed to get honored by their old students in the event.

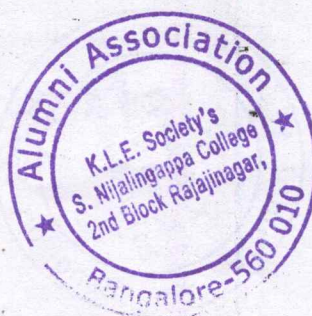


6. Shradha, student, was called upon to share her experience with regard to the event. She shared views regarding the knowledge she gained from the Alumni's speech.




7. Mr. Manjunath, Retired Forest Officer, spoke about various opportunities available to the students after their graduation. They spoke about the competitive exams.

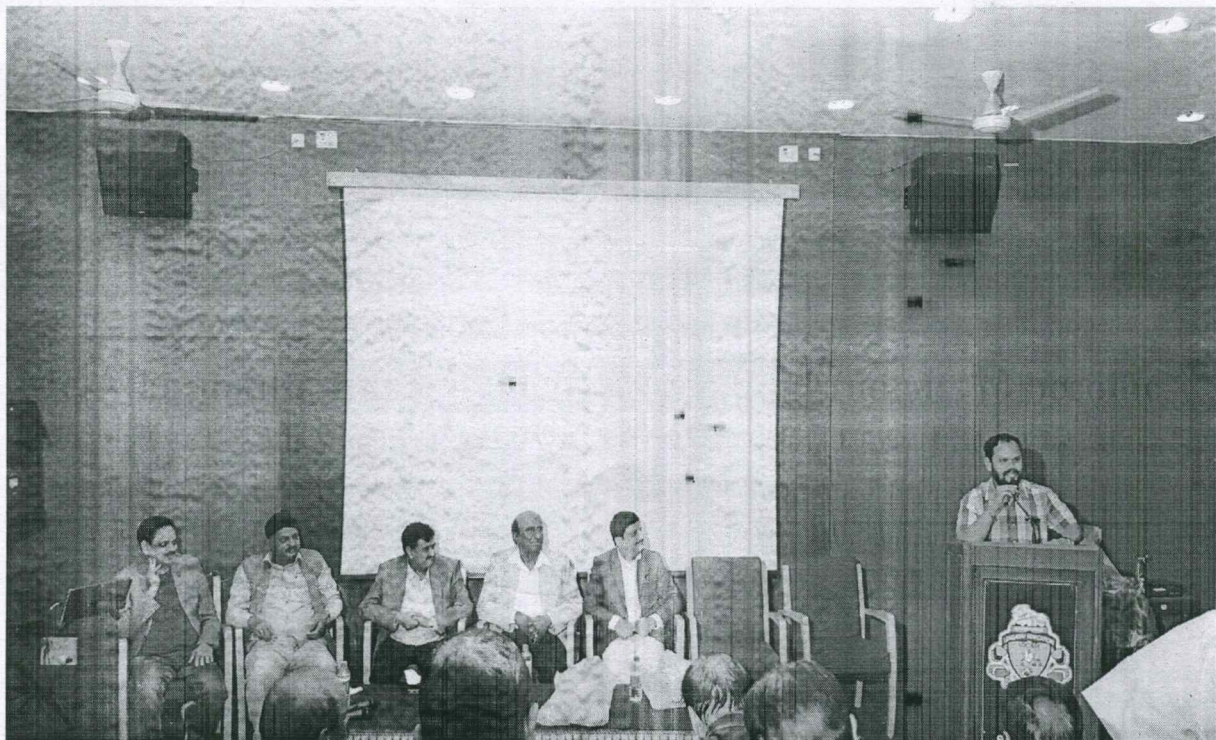

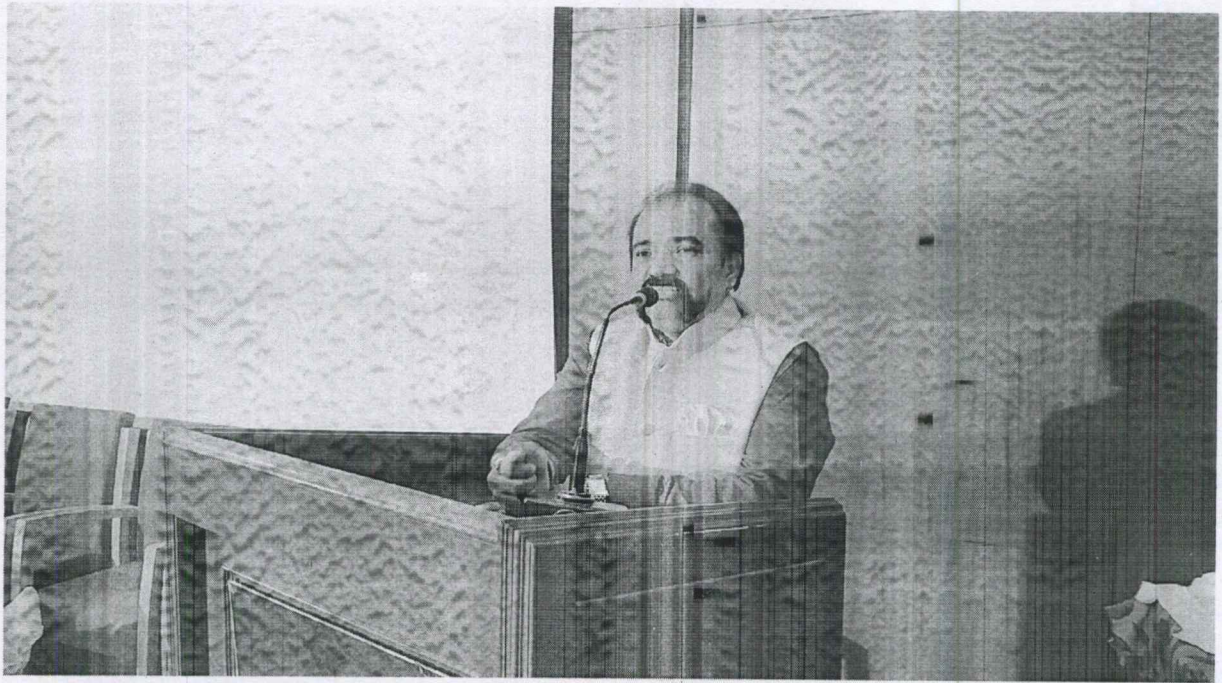

The meeting was enlightened with an invocation song by Ms. Pavithra D and Ms. Sowdhamini.

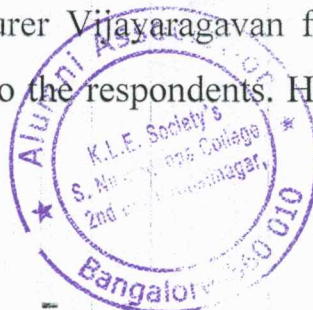
The Chief guest, dignitaries on the Dias and alumni was cordially welcomed by Ms. Yamini V H.

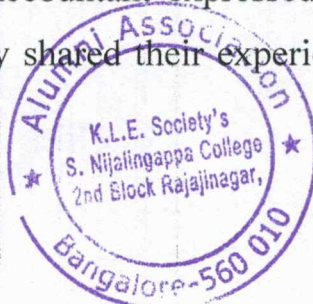

1. Mr. Rakshith, Chartered Accountant expressed his happiness for being invited to the college. They shared their experience being in the college

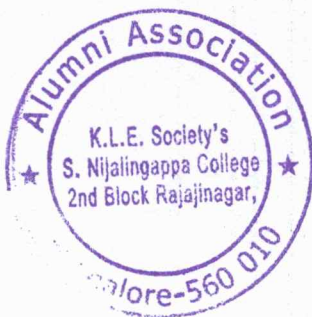


and shared that extra-curricular activities conducted in college was very helpful. They also motivated other alumni to take up the competitive exams and higher education.

Minutes of the Meeting

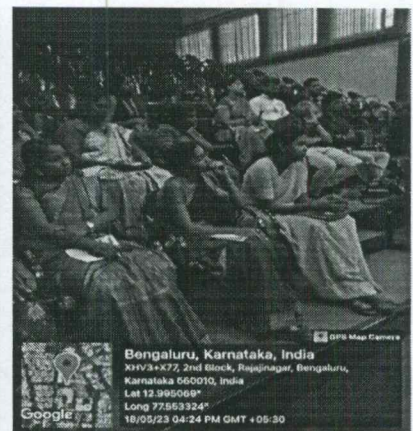
1. The minutes of the previous meeting was read, discussed and confirmed by the chair. The following was the action taken by the chair

Report on Annual Alumni Meet 2022-23

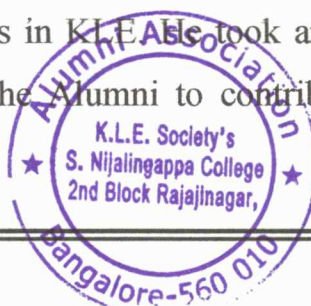

Mrs. Rekha Mohan renowned as REMO, expressed her happiness in being in Alumni Meet. She shared about study and friends during her college days. She stressed

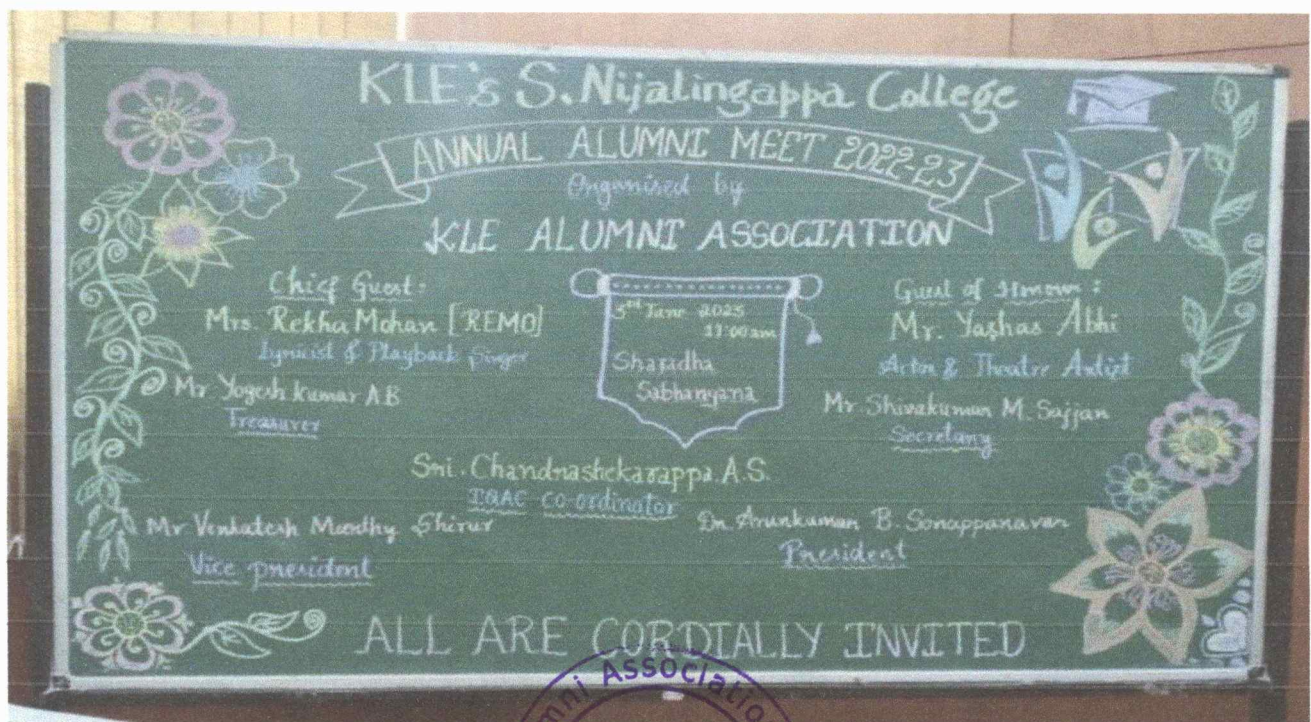

Mr. Yogesh Kumar A B, Assistant Professor, Department of Commerce and Treasurer of Alumni Association proposed the vote of thanks.

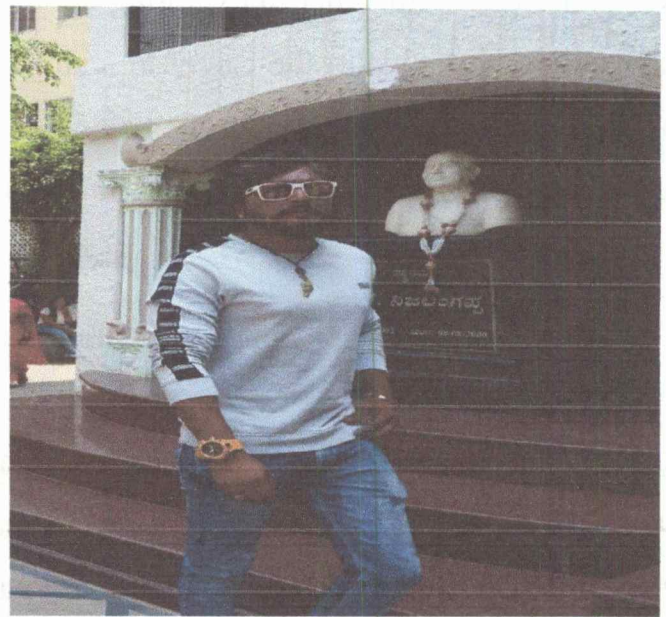
