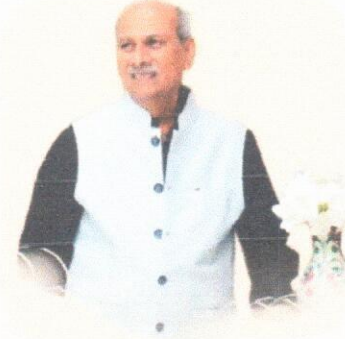

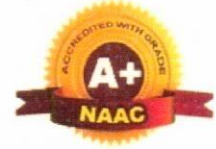

About 95 units of blood collected to treat thalassemia, cancer or other life threatening diseases. These types of diseases often demand blood infusions during the course of treatment. 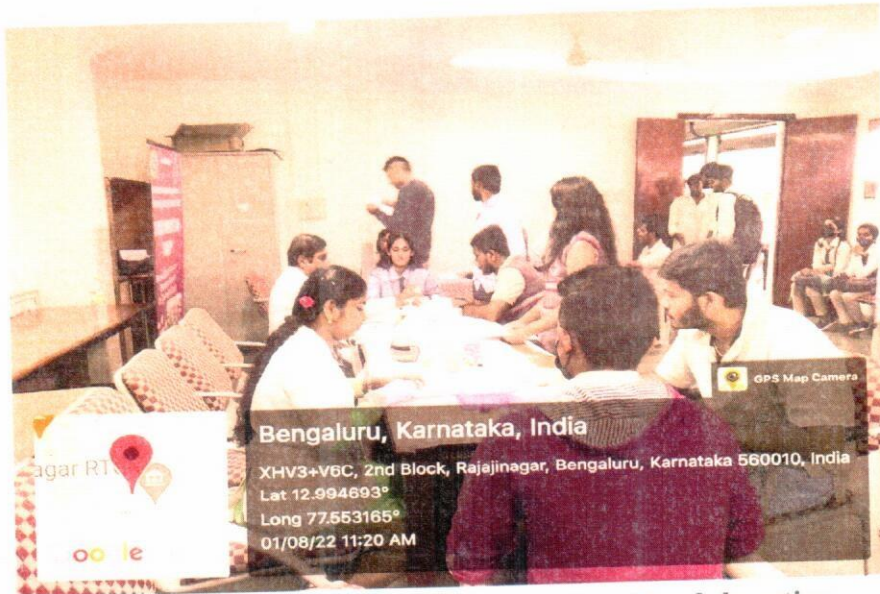

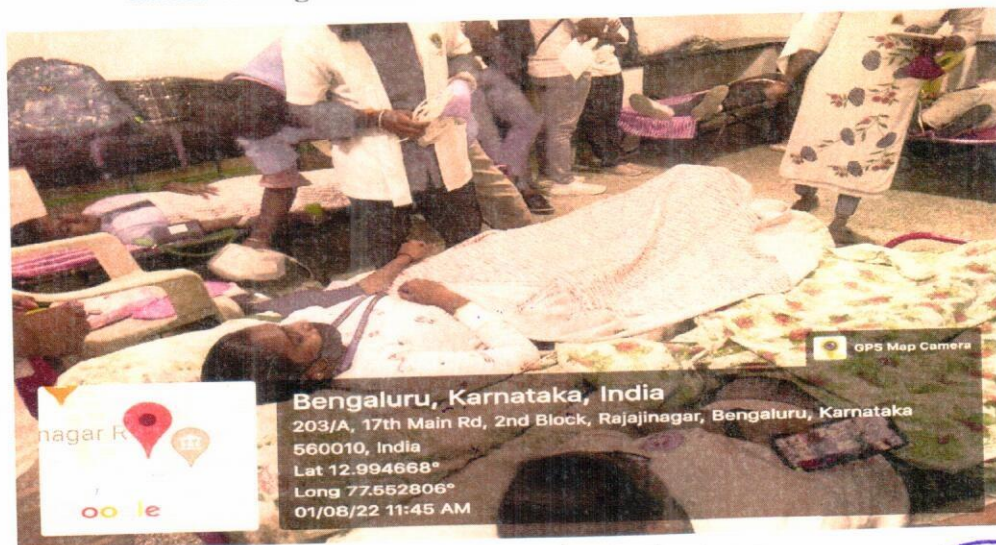
