The Department of English organized National Symposium **Trends And Challenges In Contemporary Indian Writing** on 31 October, 2018 at Sharada Sabhangan. The Symposium was inaugurated by GnanapeethAwardee , Padmashri Dr.ChandrasekharKambar, President of Sahitya Akademi, New Delhi. In his Inaugural address , Dr. Kamar narrated the influence of English Writings and Education on Regional Writing. Further , he added thatthe imitation of English literature had overshadowed the original thoughts and relevance of nativity. Yet, he did not fail to mention thepromising scenario in the Contemporary Indian Writing as there are many experimentation going on in all the vernacular languages. Dr. C. Naganna, a noted scholar and critic referred to many texts and pointed out the challenges the writers had in dealing with the themesto suit the time. In his Presidential speech, Dr. S. S. Halageri, Principal, KLES S. Nijalingappa College, mentioned the upcoming of technologyin writing which has led to the diverse interest of readers towards watsapp, messages , etc. Besides, the Inaugural ceremony was welcomedby Dr. Jayashree C. Kamar, HOD, English and was presided by Dr. S.S. Halageri, Principal.

The session commenced with Dr. VaishaliK.S., Chairman , English Department, Bangalore University. She rendered her talk on the newemerging theory on **Configuring Disability** in Indian works. This was a new thought for all the delegates which opened up the symposiumfor an exhaustive discussion on the theme. The Second Session was taken over by Dr. Krishna Manavalli, Chairman, English Department, Karnatak University, Dharwad. She startedher talk with the role Deity in literature and in particular with Kamar's novels. She also stressed on the folk element of Deityexplored in his works with the relevance to contemporary scenario with global impact.

The noted Kannada Author, Vasudhendra shared his views on the challenges that the language literature is facing due to dearth in translations. His concern was that many Indian vernacular language literature which is extremely good is not crossing the barrier of Nation. He also wished that there should be a software to translate texts technically. The valedictory note was delivered by the renowned translator and critic, Dr. Krishnamurthy Chander. He provided few tips to thedelegates on the deliberations of the day's symposium .He added that there is a need for more translations.

Shri. Vijayshankar S.R. (critic and writer), Pramod Mutalik(Translator), Mahabal Bhat, Regional Scretary, Sahitya Akademi withother few writers , Prof. Prakash C. Patil, Principal KLES Nagarbhavi, Prof. K.Nagi Reddy, UGC Co-ordinator, Heads and coordinators of various departments, teaching and nonteaching faculty and students were present. There were around 120 participants with 86 delegatesfrom Mysore, Davangere, Athani and Dharwad.
