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STEM CELL DONOR RECRUITMENT DRIVE

Youth Red Cross unit of KLE's S Nijalingappa College in association with DKMS-BMST, Foundation, India organized stem cell donor recruitment drive on 18/05/2022 for volunteers and 24/05/2022 for all students and staff to get aware of importance of stem cells.

Mr. Mazin, MS. Ashita were the resource persons from DKMS-BMST Foundation. They explained about blood cancer, importance of stem cell donation and how to become potential donor.

Around 580 students and staff participated in this drive and 152 students and staff donated their stem cells to cure blood cancer of patients. During the registration process, the potential donor signed a consent form in which they consent to the HLA-typing of their tissue samples and to the recording and storage of their data on DKMS-BMST database. Form contained bar-coded stickers for the labelling of the samples. All volunteers assisted with this step to ensure correct handling. Those details of form then entered into database and stored until the donor reaches 61 years of age at which stage their details will be erased.

During the process of collection of sample donors were asked to use the cotton swabs which were provided in sterile packaging and were accompanied by a swab envelope. Once the donor has rubbed the swabs on the inside of their cheeks for 60 seconds, the cotton swabs were left to dry for two minutes before placed into the swab envelope and sealed. At the final check desk, the donor consent forms and the corresponding cotton swab envelopes are collected and checked that all completed fully, correctly and clearly readable.

OUTCOME: Students and staff were become aware about data, causes and effects of blood cancer and also about importance of stem cells in eradication of blood cancer in future. They came forward to donate stem cells and spread that message to others and even to their family members.



College Donor Recruitment Drives

Guidelines

1. Planning the College Donor Recruitment Drive

During the College Drive planning stage, it is important to ensure that all students receive an explanation on the topic of blood cancer, stem cell donation and what is involved in becoming a potential donor. This helps raise awareness which in turn contributes to a smoother and more successful College Drive.

From experience, it is suggested to treat this project with high priority (e.g. top-down) to ensure that all students are aware of the importance of this topic. It is also very important to ask the students to seek the prior approvals of their parents to register, as parental consent will become important if the student is found to be a potential match for a patient and they are asked to donate their blood stem cells.

Nevertheless, at no time should any employee feel obliged to register, as this is a voluntary act at all times.

Informing Students

In order to make your College Drive as successful as possible, you'll need to make your students aware of the Drive as early as possible. Below are some examples of the most commonly used methods of advertising drives, with which DKMS - BMST can support:

- Display of posters with DKMS - BMST event information (notice board, reception, common rooms, on walls, in lifts, in the cafeteria)
- Information presentation via email (emailers)
- Event information shared through WhatsApp group messages
- Event information on College intranet (digital leaflets, information presentation)
- DKMS - BMST film on TV screens
- Placement of an information standees in a central area of the college.
- An editorial piece in the college/student magazine or newsletter.

It is also advisable to arrange for a seminar/ lecture/talk before the event, to give information to the students and draw up a preliminary registration list, prior to the College Drive, to ensure that students discuss this with their families and then come prepared to register on the Drive date. This will also help DKMS - BMST estimate the number of students interested in becoming a potential donor.

Date of the College Donor Recruitment Drive

When arranging the date for the College Drive, DKMS - BMST should be consulted so that we can guarantee the availability of materials, and the capacity of our laboratory and staff. If any students are unavailable on the day of the drive there is the possibility of individual

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registration on agreement with your DKMS - BMST point of contact. Please request this if necessary.

Student Volunteers

In order to organize and execute a successful College Drive, it is important to identify College students who are happy to volunteer for the day (usually NSS Volunteers, Rotaract club members, other community service volunteers, etc.). These students will be responsible for various tasks including the setup of the room, the internal marketing of the drive, and the general running of the drive.

Logistics

All materials associated with the execution of a College Drive will be supplied by DKMS - BMST and these materials will be made available on the day of the drive.

2. College Donor Recruitment Drive Processes

The preparation and implementation of a College Drive is a straight forward process and should not have any significant negative impact on your College's resources. The allocation of approximately 10-15 minutes per person for the entire registration process will be sufficient.

1. Personal Data Collection

During the registration process, the potential donor must sign a consent form in which they consent to the HLA-typing of their tissue samples and to the recording and storage of their data on DKMS - BMST database. This form also contains barcoded stickers for the labelling of the samples. A volunteer assists with this step to ensure correct handling. The details on this form will then be entered onto our database and will be stored until the donor reaches 61 years of age at which stage their details will be erased.

2. Sample Collection

Following the registration process, donors are asked to use the cotton swabs that are provided in sterile packaging and are accompanied by a swab envelope. Once the donor has rubbed the swabs on the inside of their cheeks for 60 seconds, the cotton swabs are left to dry for approximately two minutes before being placed into the swab envelope and sealed.


At the final check desk, the donor consent forms and the corresponding cotton swab envelopes are collected and checked that all is completed fully, correctly, and clearly readable.

Room Suitability

The chosen room should be easily accessible and have vivid signage leading there.

Example of ideal layout:





Volunteers and DKMS - BMST staff will sit face to face with potential donors throughout the registration process. Therefore, it is necessary to have a room that is sufficient enough in size to allow staff and potential donors to move around easily.

Please talk to your DKMS - BMST representative regarding the suitability of your space.

3. Legal Aspects

Donor Data Privacy & Confidentiality

All personal data collected by DKMS - BMST is subject to special protection pursuant to the Information Technology Act 2000 (IT Act) and other applicable provisions for data protection which we ensure by means of technical and organizational measures. Also, DKMS - BMST is obliged to follow the World Marrow Donors Association's (<http://www.wmda.info>) donor data privacy standards. Thus, all personal data collected by DKMS - BMST throughout the registration process is subject to the WMDA data protection standards and will therefore not be passed onto third parties, including the employer.

Wherever possible, we store donor data on specially protected servers. Access to personal data is only granted to specially empowered personnel of DKMS - BMST who are obligated to maintain confidentiality.

The purpose of processing donor data is to procure stem cell donations for patients in need. Only unidentifiable donor data along with the results of the typing of tissue characteristics (HLA typing) will be transmitted in an encrypted form to stem cell donor registries and healthcare institutions in India and abroad. Only such data will be transmitted which is relevant for the donor search. Essentially, this includes a donor identification number, gender, date of birth, tissue typing results, the number of tissue typing conducted to date and the donor status (available or unavailable). Names, addresses or similar identifying data will not be transmitted. The encryption of data will make the donor unidentifiable for these registries and healthcare institutions.

BMST co-operates with DKMS gemeinnützige GmbH and other healthcare service providers who receive personal data when it is necessary for this purpose. These providers are contractually obligated by DKMS - BMST to only use personal data for the proper purpose and to prevent accidental disclosure to third parties.



The Donor can request in writing the access to his/her data, including the results of any tests overseen by DKMS - BMST. The donor can also request correction or deletion of his/her data. We will only use donor data in accordance with the donor's consent, or as strictly mandated by law or good clinical practice. We will never sell donor data.

Voluntariness of Donation

Please note that at this point the donor is only agreeing to registration. If a potential donor-patient match is found further information will be provided. The donor will have the opportunity to ask questions and to withdraw at any time, for health...
donation is a voluntary act.
