KLESNC is one of the top colleges of Bengaluru awarded with highest grade <u>CGPA 3.82</u> in second NAAC cycle and A+ grade in all the three cycles. A multidisciplinary student—centric institution endeavours to transform students to be self-reliant global citizens. College is permanently affiliated to Bengaluru City University and attaining Diamond Jubilee. BHM & MCA programmes are recognised by AICTE, New Delhi. College has implemented NEP curriculum from 2020-21 with prior preparation. Recognized by <u>IIC with 2 Stars</u> for the conduct of innovative activities and BHM department secured <u>26th Rank in 'India Today'</u> MDRA for quality education. The college has bagged, 50 UG ranks and 37 PG ranks since 2018. Institute has got ISO 9001:2015 certification for quality infrastructure and student supporting facilities. College has been awarded with UGC STRIDE Component-I (2020-2023) with grant of Rs.45.95 lakhs among the 58 colleges across the country and is one among the two of the State. 4 NCC cadets participated in RDC in New Delhi. In present cycle 12617, students benefitted with INR 458.688 lakhs of scholarship.

Dimension 1: Pragmatic Learning

The College has phenomenal growth in quality enhancement with reference to programs and courses offered, student supporting facilities, values and ethics, campus placements, research, University ranks and University blues. Provision has been made to learn by performing and engaging themselves in hands on activities.

The college presently offers 22 UG programs, 9 PG, One PhD program in Commerce and 84 skill enhancing short term courses for research capacity building and human resource development beyond curriculum. College has introduced BBA Aviation Management and BTTM, MSc Computer Science & Organic Chemistry and MA English during present NAAC accreditation cycle and produced 4291⁺ graduates, 515⁺ postgraduates and 2 doctorates and guided 3 PhD in Kannada. Empirical learning is practiced through communication for soft skill



development, confidence building, managerial and entrepreneurship skills and self-reliance measures. Institute provides training for competitive examinations through Sparda Sachetana Centre and placement cell which helps students to pursue higher education, employment and public service in public & corporate sectors. College has collaborated with employers, companies with <u>55 MoUs</u> for career guidance & placements. 10+ UG students have progressed for higher education at overseas.

The strength of the college lays in its highly qualified and dedicated teaching faculty. 45 teachers hold Doctoral degree, 8 MPhil, 19 qualified NET, 26 KSET/SLET and 14 are pursuing PhD programs in present NAAC cycle. Senior faculties serve on the Board of Studies, on Board of Examination and text book committees of Bangalore University and Bengaluru City University.

Dimension 2: Service Learning

Students of KLESNC go through participative, experiential learning and community engaging services. In this process departments, NCC, NSS and YRC units link personal and social development of students with academic and cognitive development which helps them in moulding as responsible citizens with empathy and work towards social justice. With this regard institute has **adopted 2 villages** Doddamudigere & Ghanakallu under Amrit Samudaya Abivrudhi Scheme and **9 schools** under School Bell Programme. NSS, YRC and NCC organized blood donation camps and donated **1252 units of blood**, health & hygiene and social awareness programmes, rallies, health check-up camps, Pulse Polio Drives, 25 Eye and 456 cms hair donation, 553 Stem cell donations and annual camps in adopted villages.

During Covid pandemic college has organised 6 nasopharyngeal tests and 6 Vaccination drives (First, Second & Booster). College has donated two-day salary and two lorries of essential commodities for flood victims of North Karnataka. BHM department provide **consultancy service** to Rajabhavan, Govt. of Karnataka & other institutions and earned **10.487 lakhs**.

Dimension 3: Green learning

Eco-club, NSS and NCC units of the college organized various extension and outreach programmes to take the students beyond classroom learning to explore the value of nature and engaging with soil in order to safe guard and conserve the natural resources. Faculty and students have participated in awareness rallies, street plays, dramas, competitions, plant adoptions, distribution of seed balls, tree census, technical naming of the plants & their



medicinal uses. College takes care of campus environment, energy and greenery by internal and external audit committees. The college Initiate to develop eco-friendly campus by practicing landscaping, gardening, garbage disposal, vermicomposting, medicinal gardens, water fountains, stone cascades, vehicle and plastic free campus.

Dimension 4: Innovative Learning

Institution believes in inspiring the students for research, innovation and creative thinking transforming them into skilful human resource. All the departments, R&D cell, IIC & NISP accelerate the opportunity for faculty and students to involve in mobilise the funds for research, internships, projects, workshops and hands-on trainings.

Senior faculty members are resource persons contributing towards research in science and humanities, pedagogy, NAAC accreditation, literature, business management, herbal techniques and industry-oriented experiments in other higher education institutions. The college practices student centric curriculum, co-curricular and extracurricular activities to hone the students in all the aspects to develop leadership qualities.

The college has organized **03-International** seminars and 4-conferences; 15 national seminars, 2- conferences, 4-workshops and 1-Entreunership development programs and 1-symposium. 09 FDPs, 33 SDPs, 66 Prominent Day Celebration events, 3-Poster Presentations, 45 student Orientation Programs, 08 student Induction Programmes, 18 Fests, 08 Trade Fair, 33 Exhibitions, 85 Industrial visits/ study tours, 192 Field survey & visits, 59 extension activities, 05 outreach programmes, 63 Intercollegiate competitions, 66 Inter class competitions, 24 Awareness programmes and 05 Faculty exchange programs.
