A separation process is a method that converts a mixture or a solution of chemical substances into two or more distinct product mixtures. A scientific process of separating two or more substance in order to obtain purity. At least one product mixture from the separation is enriched in one or more of the source mixture's constituents. In some cases, a separation may fully divide the mixture into pure constituents. Processes are often classified according to the particular properties they exploit to achieve separation. If no single

If no single difference can be used to accomplish the desired separation, multiple operations can often be combined to achieve the desired end.

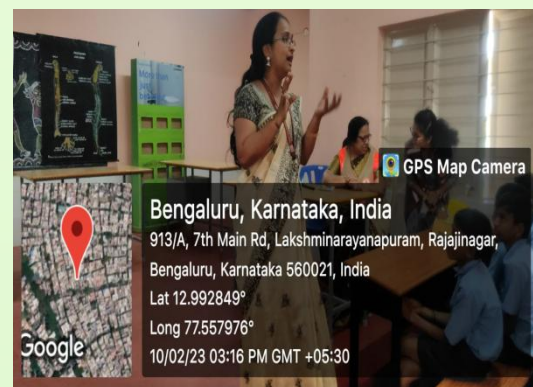

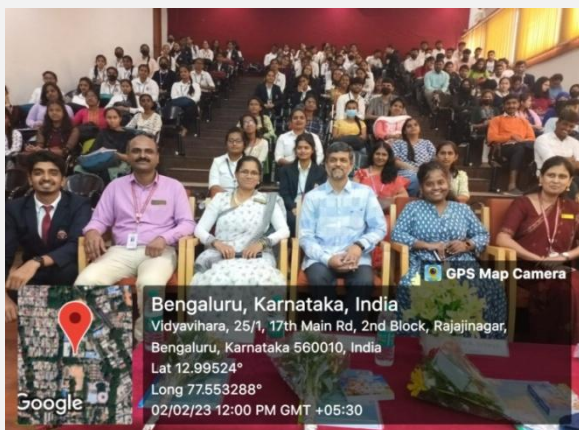
## Recent Advances in Biomarker Discovery

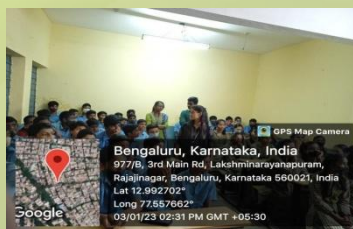
