Madam

We have collected the feedback from Chemistry students, Alumni of our College, faculty of other colleges who visited our college during practical exams and from industry person who visit us during placement and as resource person regarding the syllabus of the university. Those suggestions were analyzed and summarized as follows.

1. Curriculum for semester should be reduced to 48 hours instead of 56 hours, since during the semester we are not able to complete syllabus
2. Practical experiments are also should be reduced from 16 experiments to 12 experiments due scarcity of time able to complete all experiments
3. Regularly BOS meetings should be conducted to discuss the problems incurred during delivery of syllabus
4. Equal weight age should be given all the branches of chemistry including biochemistry
5. Selection of experiments should involve the skills required for industry
6. Students research projects should be included in the syllabus
7. Students should be exposed to industrial visit
8. Question paper pattern should be changed which involves concept understanding
